Race Car Noise Testing Rules



1. The Race Car Noise Testing Session will take place during a Vintage Car Racing event organized by the Vintage Auto Racing Association of Canada (VARAC) in partnership with the British Auto Racing Club-Ontario Centre (BARC). This event and this session is held under CASC-OR General Competition rules, CASC-OR Race Regulations and CASC-OR Permit. This rule set applies to the Noise Testing Session

2. Key Personnel: VARAC' managers of this session are:

Testing will be performed by our Chief Scrutineer, Mike Nilson who is a qualified SCCA Sound Technician.

3. Every circuit we race on is different and the noise measuring protocols vary circuit to circuit. As such, the results from this testing are indicative only. They are not to be considered as a pass or fail for other circuits/events.

4. This is an on-track test. All racing regulations, Conduct procedures and protocols apply ie only licenced drivers are to drive the car; full driver equipment to be worn; full restraint system to be applied. Please obey all flagging and race official instructions.

5. The measurement will take place during an “on-off” single lap on the Pro Circuit (ie simulating a Dynamic Test). Cars will be released at approx. 20 sec intervals from the grid. Proceed at a reasonable pace to the back straight. Maintain a reasonable gap to the proceeding car. Do not pass any cars unless they are pulled over/disabled. The measuring zone will be marked with cones. Accelerate hard but safely to and through the measuring zone. Respect your braking zone for the end of the straight. Once off the straight, proceed on the course to pit-out. Exit the track. DO NOT MAKE ANOTHER LAP.

6. Only entered and “teched” race cars are eligible.

7. Driver’s Briefing: A mandatory briefing on this session will take place after the formal Driver’s meeting Sat AM

8. Results: Results will be radio’d from the test area to the CASC trailer/pit area. Results will be available immediately.

9. Timing: This session will be shown on the overall event schedule posted on the VARAC website under the Peter Jackson 2022 folder. Note the schedule is subject to change and if there are delays in the racing program, this session may be cancelled.
